WHAT IS EXPECTED OF A HOST FAMILY?

- Be available to host player(s) from the beginning of June through the middle of August. Keep in mind players are on the road approximately 50% of the season.
- Provide a clean, non-smoking, safe and pleasant environment for player(s) to stay.
- Provide a private room with a bed for each player (players can share a room with another player, but need to have their own bed).
- Provide access to a bathroom.
- Provide the player(s) with meals/food (when they are in town).
- Provide access to your laundry equipment (players do their own laundry).
- Assist with arranging player transportation to/from the ballpark as needed (some players will have their own vehicles and often players will carpool with each other)

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF THE PLAYERS?

- Positive role modeling in the community and within the host family's home.
- Following and being respectful of all family/household rules.
- Doing their own laundry.
- Picking up after themselves in common areas of the home.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF BEING A HOST FAMILY?

- Two premium tickets per player or general admission for each family member (living within your household) to all Applesox home games.
- 20% discount on fee for Applesox summer baseball camp for host family children that meet the age criteria for the camp.
